MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

When using **Vigorate** with wettable powders and water soluble materials, add **Vigorate** in water before adding pesticide to spray tank. For emulsifiable products, add **Vigorate** after emulsion has been formed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- Herbicides, Defoliants, Desiccants: Use 1 to 4 pints/100 gallons of spray mixture.
- 2) Insecticides, Fungicides, Acaracides, Plant Growth Regulators, Foliar Nutrients: Use 1 to 4 pints/100 gallons of spray mixture.
- Turf, Ornamentals and Industrial Spraying: Use 1 to 4 pints per 100 gallons of spray mixture.
